Debbi Rett, B.S. | Physical Therapist



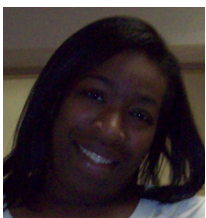

Dana Ciechanowski, B.A. | Residential Supervisor



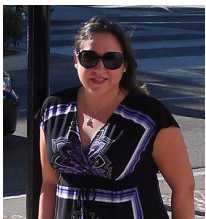
