Our Structured Community Program for Brain Injury in **Traverse City** provides the appropriate amount of support and supervision, while allowing participants the opportunity to regain their independence and continue to move along our continuum of post-acute rehabilitation and care options. In this program, we work in partnership with local community providers to provide occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech language pathology and comprehensive neuropsychological evaluation.

Our supports and services provided in our **East Bay** Licensed Residential Programs for Brain and Spinal Cord injury offer structured opportunities for maximum skill development aimed at increasing independence and safety. Our two homes are in close proximity to local community highlights such as downtown, fishing, skiing, boating and local festivals. Focus is placed on community integration while offering services to people who require 24-hour care.

**Whitehall** is a warm and welcoming community located on White Lake and beautiful Lake Michigan. This program provides a wide range of Transitional, Structured Community Programs for Brain Injury and Licensed Residential Programming for Brain and Spinal Cord injury in community-based settings to individuals and their families in Western Michigan. The specially trained staff helps individuals integrate into work, volunteer, social and educational opportunities and encourages them to achieve their potential.

**Clarkston** offers Transitional Services including home and community-based rehabilitation of traumatic brain injury, spinal cord injury and severe orthopedic trauma patients. The program delivers quality physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech and language pathology, medical social work and massage therapy to individuals and their families in South East Michigan.

**Harbor Rehabilitation**, located in **Grand Rapids**, provides home and community-based rehabilitation services for children, adolescents, and adults who have sustained brain and spinal cord injuries, and other neurological or orthopedic challenges.

We offer Structured Community, Neurorehabilitation and Transitional programs for Brain and Spinal Cord Injury; including Occupational Therapy, Speech Language Pathology, Nursing, Psychological counseling and group therapy in community based settings in **Ann Arbor**.
