NeuroRestorative Timber Ridge's pediatric program provides rehabilitation and academic services to children and adolescents, ages 4-17, with brain injury and other neurological challenges. Our individualized treatment plans help young people reach appropriate developmental milestones and build the skills and confidence they need to be successful.

Our Treatment Approach

Our interdisciplinary team of therapists, special education professionals, life skills trainers and clinicians work hand-inhand with each child and their family to design an individualized treatment plan that includes restorative therapies, behavior intervention strategies, education goals, family training and home re-entry supports. Additionally, we do not lose sight of the unique social needs of children and adolescents. Our program fosters friendships and creates an environment with ample opportunities for peer-to-peer interaction.

Family Support

The NeuroRestorative Timber Ridge pediatric treatment team understands that family involvement is a critical component of recovery for a child or adolescent. Our team works to bridge the distance during out-of-home treatment, and help families understand what to expect after treatment. Case managers oversee each child's treatment and discharge plan. Upon discharge we partner with families and traditional educational institutions to ensure a smooth transition back to a less structured setting.
